The Details:

Date: Activity is available most Wednesdays starting in July for 10 weeks

Time: 3hrs within 3:00pm-9:00pm

Number of Volunteers: 6-10

Location: 40 Oak Street and Big Park, Regent Park

The Need:

Taste of Regent Park is a family-friendly summer food festival that animates Regent Park's namesake green space, also known as the Big Park. This celebration of food, community and culture features:

- An affordable produce market providing seasonal fruits and vegetables.
- A pay-what-you-can community meal is cooked each week by local caterers.
- Local artisanal food and handicraft vendors have goods for sale, alongside local community agency tables, and performances by local artists.

Volunteers are needed to help with setting up the event space, staffing the produce market and children's activities, and helping serve the community meal.

The Activity:

- A short introduction on what your team can expect from the day
- Tasks could include:
 - Helping with setting up the event space in the park (tents, tables)
 - Helping with setting up children's activity booth and helping staff the booth
 - Helping with serving the community meal
 - Helping with tearing down the event space in the park
